## Playing Outside

As you know, we encourage all children to play outside every day, throughout the year. Some parents are concerned that this is making their child unwell. However, this has been proved to be beneficial by the medical profession. Children are more likely to catch colds and bugs when only able to play inside due to the warm environment. We will always make sure your child is well wrapped up before playing outside – please ensure they dress appropriately for the weather. School currently have 96 children attending on a daily basis, and we are expecting more to join us in January. Due to the increasing numbers of children, we are unable to promise to keep your child inside at all times, but we will ensure they are warm and dry.

## Home time for full-time children

Full-time children are to be collected by 3pm. The door will open from 2.55pm. This is to protect the children's final teaching session of the day, ensuring it is not disrupted by lots of coming and going. A few parents have a prior agreement with the Headteacher that they can collect their child earlier than this due to personal circumstances. 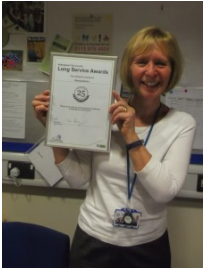


## Admission to Reception
