Nature of support

Additional support from teaching assistants in the classroom, small-group tuition, a specific homework group, etc.

- Children with EYPP are targeted according to the latest assessments and tracking and receive extra input according to that identified need [attainment or slower progress in one or more areas of learning]
- Children with EYPP are targeted during continuous provision according to their need
- Children with EYPP are identified for key people and given extra support or challenge during group times by the teacher or early years practitioners supporting that group
- Intervention groups in literacy, maths and communication
- Additional after school clubs

Curriculum focus of EYPP spending

Supporting six pupils in mathematics, with a focus on number work.

Supporting five children in literacy, with a focus on early reading skills

Supporting five children in communication, with a focus on vocabulary

Supporting nine very able children by giving increased challenge during continuous provision [challenge bags]

Supporting 16 children and their families with home learning with book bags and rhyme sharing

Enhancement activities such as tap dancing and after school Forest Garden Clubs are offered free of charge for those receiving EYPP

Out of school trips such as museum and art gallery are offered free of charge for those receiving EYPP
